Singapore, 28 June 2011 – The annual Singapore Food Festival supported by the Singapore Tourism Board is back and this year's theme is "Curry and Spices". This certification assesses the environmental management system in a foodcourt from its environmental policies to water, energy and waste management.

City Square Mall is the first mall in Singapore designed with eco education and awareness in mind. One of the many eco-sensitive features is the double glazed façade glass that allows plenty of natural light into the building. Several F&B outlets on the upper floors offer alfresco seating for a bright, cheery dining experience in the day, and intimate dining at night.
