E-waste is any electronic or electrical item that one no longer find usable or useful. Due to space constraints, large and bulky items such as washing machines and TV sets will not be accepted. The mall welcomes all types and brands of electronic and electrical equipment for recycling, including the following:

#### **IT Equipment**

Battery chargers, cables, computer mice, desktops, docking stations, hard disk drives, keyboards, laptop, mobile phone batteries, mobile phones, modems, monitors, plugs, tablets and telephones.

#### **Home Appliances**

Blenders, electric fans, electric kettles, food processors and radios.

From 5 June to 6 July, participants who trade in their e-waste at the L2 Customer Service Counter will receive an eco-bag from City Square Mall, limited to the first 1,000 participants and one eco-bag per person per day.

The public can look forward to educational eco-related activities at City Square Mall, including an exhibition by National Environment Agency (NEA) between 5 to 6 July at B1 MRT Entrance. In a bid to raise awareness and educate the public on how to reduce their carbon footprint, the exhibition will highlight some tips for safeguarding our environment to ensure sustainable and quality living for present and future generations. There will also be eco-related games at the exhibition between 2 to 5pm on both days.
